As our COVID testing and inpatient volumes continue to decline and are at their lowest daily rolling averages since early last fall, drive up COVID-19 testing hours will be reduced.

Beginning Monday, March 1, we will reduce the drive up COVID-19 testing hours to 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Testing will continue to be conducted outside of the Emergency Department Entrance and patients will still need a prescription from their physician in order to be tested.
