

Registered Nurse Student Externship Program

Program Details

The Student Nurse Externship is an 8-week, paid, summer, specialty-focused program. Externs will work with a registered nurse observing and participating in supervised patient care. Externs will also benefit from three, four-hour simulation lab education sessions practicing and enhancing the following skills:

- Focused Adult Physical Assessment
- Team Role in Cardiac Arrest Code
- IV Insertion and Management
- PICC and Central Line Management
- Foley Insertion
- Chest Tube Management
- Suctioning
- Commonly used Equipment Review

Critical Care Nursing:

- ICU
- Emergency Department
- 3 West-Telemetry/Stroke Unit
- Clinical Observation Unit

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Medical Surgical Nursing:

- 1 West Surgical/Orthopedics Unit
- 2 East Medical Surgical, Chemotherapy, Palliative Care Unit

Criteria and Requirements

To qualify for the program you must:

- Attend an accredited school of nursing recognized by a Board of Nursing
- Be entering the final year or semester of nursing school
- Maintain a 3.0 or better GPA in nursing courses

NOTE - Criteria requirements will be validated with a school representative.
