

# UHELP Scholarship Application Guidelines

## Application

Applicant must meet the following criteria in order to be eligible:

- Current employee in good standing of WVU Medicine Uniontown Hospital or Fayette Regional Health System
- No disciplines within the previous 12 month period greater than a verbal or coaching
- Registered, or will be registering, to attend an accredited RN or BSN program

Applicant must submit the following by the defined deadline in order to be considered:

- Completed application. To access the application, go to <http://www.grantinterface.com/Process/Apply?urlkey=cffayettepascholarship>
- Student Aid Report (SAR)
  - The SAR is received following the completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid application; FAFSA
  - The FAFSA can be completed online. Go to <https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa> for details
- UHELP Essay (See Application Instructions for details)

## Selection Process

The WVU Medicine Uniontown Hospital Scholarship Committee will con-

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sist of a diverse group of clinical and non-clinical FRHS and Hospital representatives, including a representative from Volunteer Services.

The Committee receives application packets for review. The applicant's name and financial information (SAR) will be redacted from the application packets by the Education Department Administrative Secretary.

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## Awards

Employees can only apply once per defined school year. A defined school year is Fall and Spring Semester.

Maximum award of \$2,000 per applicant for the defined school year, which is Fall Semester and Spring Semester consecutively. For example, if you register for Fall and Spring Semester, your school will receive up to \$1,000 each semester towards your tuition.

Award payments are made each semester to the accredited school at which you are registered to attend. Any refunds or unused portions of the UHELP Scholarship will be refunded directly from the school to the UHELP Scholarship fund.
